Plastic Bags

March 1, 2020

New York State has prohibited the distribution of single-use plastic bags.

Penalties will be imposed under New York State law for violations.


Foam Products

March 1, 2019

New York City businesses may no longer offer, sell or posess foam food containers.

Foam packing peanuts are banned and may not be offered or sold by manufacturers or stores in New York City.

Plastic Straws

November 1, 2021 New York City food service establishments may no longer offer

plastic straws and stir sticks, except upon request of a customer.

Compostable plastic straws and stir sticks are permitted.
